Community work has been the backbone of InfoBuzz work since 1996. Through visiting youth clubs or parking our information bus on cold winter nights in a variety of locations around the county, we have delivered support and guidance to young people.

This work continues today in a variety forms and guises but not, we're afraid, on the bus!

Working closely with a variety of local authority and statutory agencies as well as partners in the voluntary sector, InfoBuzz can provide the majority of the programs outlined in this portfolio in most settings. In addition to this, we offer our targeted intervention program free of charge to any individual or group deemed to be experiencing problems or concerns around substances.

InfoBuzz are particularly keen to engage with groups who would be interested in taking part in project work that produces topical and informative outcomes for other young people. Below is a selection of projects we have initiated or supported in conjunction with local community groups around the county.

How does it affect you? - Film Project

Short information film showing the variety of impacts that substances can have on individuals and which supports our one to one and small group intervention work with young people at risk.

Safer Driving Project

Worked with a small group of young drivers to produce an information film about the dangers of driving under the influence of drink or drugs. The young people provided invaluable tips and advice for other young drivers in relation to their own learning experience.



Rural Community Project

Empowered a group of local young people in a remote rural area to join and influence their local residents association to help alleviate tensions between older residents and perceived anti-social behaviour.
