

The Streets

Citizenship interactive board game. Played in groups, the game encourages participants to consider real life dilemmas, scenarios and problematic situations around substances, the law, keeping safe and being a good citizen.

Please note: Additional support staff may be required to run as a board game for groups with special needs.

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Target Group	Age 11-14 yrs, mixed or single gender. Can be adapted and run to meet all needs.
Group Size	Groups from 3 to 30
Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increased knowledge of how to access support services for themselves and others. • Increased understanding of the consequences of involvement in illegal activities • Increased understanding of health risks in relation to illegal and legal substances. • Increased awareness of responsibilities within the community • Increased awareness of other people's obligations under the law and how it may impact on young people. • Increased confidence in evaluation of situations and decision making.

Duration/time	60 – 90 minutes (to include setting up time)
Required environment	Large table (for small groups between 3-8) Room with clear floor space and chairs in a circle (medium groups 9-15) Dining hall, drama studio or gym (large groups 15+) If a classroom is being used, tables and chairs need to be pre-arranged to accommodate floor space.
